The Manship School professors and instructors nominate students for the program and submit the names to the selection committee at the station. WBRZ reviews nominee resumes and conducts interviews before making a final selection. The Apprentice will be employed by WBRZ for a period of one year (June to May), with full benefits of a regular full-time employee, and given broad exposure to duties and operations of a Television Station. WBRZ hopes to encourage good students to go into the Television medium and become leaders in their field of specialty, whether it is News, Sports, Weather, Production, Marketing, Sales, Operations, Engineering, or Management. Often, the Apprentice has chosen to continue as a permanent employee with WBRZ after their Apprentice term is over.
