Interns are enrolled in an internship or independent study course for grade and curriculum credit, and WBRZ managers provide written evaluations of the interns' progress as requested.

Two students enrolled and attending class full-time in a broadcast curriculum at a Louisiana four-year college will receive equivalent to \$2,000 per semester, totaling \$4,000 for the academic year.
