Good morning. An FYI,

Early this morning, troopers attempted to stop a vehicle in Ouachita Parish. The driver fled thru two parishes in excess of 110 mph, eventually crashing. Troopers attempted to place the driver under arrest. But, a violent, lengthy struggle took place. After some time struggling with the suspect, Troopers were joined by a Union Parish deputy and were able to take the suspect into custody. EMS was summoned to assess the suspect's injuries. The suspect remained combative but became unresponsive shortly before EMS arrived. The suspect was later pronounced dead at the hospital.

We are investigating the suspect's death.

State Police takes no action against trooper who lied about Ronald Greene body cam footage

Governor Edwards,

This evening, I was contacted by Rep. Ted James and advised of the above WBRZ new article. The article speaks of an investigation I initiated into Lt. John Clary regarding allegations that he lied about possessing body worn camera footage of the Ronald Greene incident.

Earlier this year, I instructed a select group of DPS personnel to initiate a review of the body worn camera program. During the administrative review of the Greene incident, participating



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Earlier this year, I instructed a select group of DPS personnel to initiate a review of the body worn camera program. During the administrative review of the Greene incident, participating personnel discovered three videos, previously submitted from Lt. Clary's body worn camera that were not part of the original evidence submitted to District Attorney John Belton with the case report in May 2019.

We determined that these videos were logged and submitted to evidence.com by Lt. Clary on the day of the incident. They were also used in the disciplinary procedures for Trooper Kory York and were previously submitted to federal investigators.

Out of an abundance of caution, I instructed our personnel to provided these videos to federal investigators and to District Attorney Belton's office.

Additionally, I opened an internal investigation into this matter. The



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Additionally, I opened an internal investigation into this matter. The investigation revealed that Lt. Clary logged and submitted the videos in evidence.com in accordance with LSP policy.

As a result of information discovered, I/A Investigators learned that three current and two former LSP employees were involved in conducting the initial investigation. We attempted to interview both of the former employees. Both declined to be interviewed.

Upon interviewing the three current employees, I/A Investigators determined that all three of their statements contradicted one another.

As a result, I/A investigators lacked sufficient evidence to sustain Lt. Clary on any policy violations nor possessed sufficient evidence to move into a criminal investigation.

The original case agent corrected



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The original case agent corrected the original case report by initiating a supplemental report and delivered it to reviewing authorities.

The administrative investigation was closed in July of 2021 with a finding of Not Sustained due to insufficient evidence to prove or disprove the allegation that Lt. Clary intentional withheld the video evidence. No discipline was delivered as a result of the investigation.

I plan to conduct a press conference on Friday to speak about the process and the measures taken to ensure this doesn't occur again.
